

WEEE DIRECTIVE & POLICY STATEMENT



Background

The 2012/19/EU Directive on Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE) became European Law in February 2003. The Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment Regulations 2013 is the underpinning UK legislation.

The above set collection, recycling and recovery targets for all types of electrical goods and impose the responsibility for the disposal of waste electrical and electronic equipment on the manufacturer of such equipment. Such equipment should also carry the WEEE logo (shown above) to indicate that it cannot be sent to landfill and must be disposed of correctly.

Our Policy

As the directive only applies to finished goods (equipment), the majority of Verotec's products, being subassemblies & components, are not affected. For applicable products (such as stand-alone fan trays & systems) we include the WEEE logo and offer a scheme to customers where by product can be returned to Verotec to be disposed of in an environmentally-friendly way.
